
A Client Story - Chris

Diagnosed with breast cancer in 1991, Chris was successfully treated and living well for 19 years. She raised her then 1, 4, and 6 year old sons. And then it happened, her cancer returned and presented in her bones and lymph nodes, and within 3 years was in her brain and spinal cord. Chris began the journey as a metastatic cancer patient, in therapy, on experimental clinical trials, and more. Somehow, she found her way to the Healing Garden too. Slowly she tested the waters with Yoga, journal writing, and T'ai Chi and Chi Gong. We have watched her smile grow a bit wider, her serenity feels more palpable, and her living is ever more alive. While statistics say she should have already faced the end of her life, she has not. She is flourishing, and deeply engaged in mindful living — from her beautiful periwinkle blue clothing, to her appreciation of nature, and personal practices in writing and mindful movement, all learned and/or strengthened by her participation at the Healing Garden. Chris has published essays on her cancer journey in the book The Thoughts and Struggles of Living with Metastatic Cancer — her blog, Chriscancerjourney.wordpress.com, is well worth a look.

FY14 Impact

- 336 active clients; 72 newly added this year
- 1,860 client visits in total
- 35 Clients provided with 201 sessions of free care subsidized through Fund A Need
- \$23,500 in pro bono therapeutic services provided make comprehensive care affordable
- Client volume averages 66 individuals per month, a 20% increase over last year
- 65% increase in the number of workshops and programs offered
- 79% increase in the number of individuals served by workshops and programs
- 35% increase in support group utilization
- 72% of surveyed clients report the Healing Garden was extremely important in the reduction of social isolation
- 86% of surveyed clients report the Healing Garden was extremely important in improving their quality of life
- 93% of surveyed clients report participation in the Healing Garden cancer support helped them resume 'normal' living in work life, social life and duties at home
- Sensory Garden is now complete, making active Horticultural Therapy a reality
- Established partnership with Lesley University offering a Healing Garden Expressive Arts Therapy Internship program

FY14 has been a year of continuing growth. Through an Angel donor, the Healing Garden has been able to bring in a much needed Director of Development, allowing us to focus on the essential fundraising needed for sustainability. The grounds, gardens and special outdoor features, landscaped and maintained by volunteers alone, has been completed. Our partnerships with clinical staff at cancer centers is expanding, and so today more than ever, people with cancer can receive integrated care that addresses how the body and the mind together can help us to heal.
